



Business Description

Duro Felguera SA is a Spain based company engaged in executing turnkey projects for the energy, industrial and oil and gas sectors. It supplies specialized services for industries and manufactures capital goods. The company is involved in carrying out integrated projects for the construction of power generation plants, mineral treatment and bulk-handling facilities, fuel storage plants and other facilities and installations for the oil and gas industry. In the services area, the organization specializes in the erection of energy and industrial facilities. The business segments of the group are Energy; Mining and Handling; Oil and Gas; Services; Manufacturing of capital goods; and Communications

Valuation ^Qas of 11 May 2024

Duro Felguera achieves a 3-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system.

The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 0.66, above the previous closing price of 0.57. The stock has been trading between a 40.75% and 0.5% discount to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 68th percentile in the coverage universe and 53rd percentile in the industrials sector (higher percentile indicates more undervalued).

The quantitative uncertainty rating for Duro Felquera is Very High.

Our quantitative star rating remains unchanged over the past year; the uncertainty rating last differed on 02/28/2024, when it was High.

The main drivers of the company's valuation and uncertainty are its earnings yield and drawdown. The earnings yield of 7.50% falls at the 78th percentile in the equity universe and the 76th percent-

ile in its sector. The trailing 12-month maximum drawdown of 28.18% corresponds to the 48th percentile overall and the 55th percentile in the industry.

Economic Moat ^Q as of 13 May 2024

Quantitatively, we do not believe Duro Felguera has an economic moat. Its moat score of 0.48 corresponds to the 44th percentile in the industrials sector. Furthermore, this rating last differed from its previous rating of Narrow on 07/03/2023, when the company's moat score fell from its maximum of 0.72 (score of 1 indicates greatest economic moat). The company also maintains a quantitative financial health rating of Moderate. Its score sits at the 34th percentile overall and the 32nd percentile in the sector

Examining the company's financials and market statistics, we find these ratings are principally driven by its enterprise value and annualized trailing 12-month volatility. The enterprise value is 259.42 million, sitting at the 43rd percentile in the industrials sector. The company's annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 24.62%, corresponding to the 33rd percentile in the equity coverage universe and the 37th percentile in the sector.


Duro Felguera maintains earnings per share of 0.06. We do not have enough information to report on the company's return-on-invested-capital and dividend yield.



Given the nature of the quantitative report and the quantitative ratings, there is no one analyst in which a given report is attributed to; however, Mr. Lee Davidson, Head of Quantitative Research for Morningstar, Inc., is responsible for overseeing the methodology that supports the quantitative equity ratings used in this report. As an employee of Morningstar, Inc., Mr. Davidson is guided by Morningstar, Inc.'s Code of Ethics and Personal Securities Trading Policy in carrying out his responsibilities.

Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings).

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

- i. Quantitative Fair Value Estimate: Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. - ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide — assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None — assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

- iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%
Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15%
but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

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- i. Last Close Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.
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Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk Categories (negligible, low, medium, high, severe). These risk categories are absolute, meaning that a 'high risk' assessment reflects a comparable degree



of unmanaged ESG risk across all subindustries covered.

The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale.
