


Business Description

Pharma Mar SA is engaged in the research, development, production, and commercialization of bioactive principles of marine origin for application in oncology. It also produces and market insecticides and air fresheners for household use, household products, wood treatment and decoration products, paints, and similar products. Its operating business segments are Oncology, Diagnostics, Consumer chemicals, and RNAi. The company obtains its revenues from two main areas: biopharmaceuticals and consumer chemicals, but the biopharmaceuticals is the main line of business.

Valuation ^Qas of 14 May 2024

Pharma Mar achieves a 3-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system.

The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 42.54, above the previous closing price of 34.12. The stock has been trading between a 47.54% and 9.38% discount to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 55th percentile in the coverage universe and 70th percentile in the healthcare sector (higher percentile indicates more undervalued).

The quantitative uncertainty rating for Pharma Mar is High.

Our quantitative star rating remains unchanged over the past year; the uncertainty rating last differed on 05/03/2024, when it was Very High.

The main drivers of the company's valuation and uncertainty are its earnings yield and drawdown. The earnings yield of 0.33% falls at the 38th percentile in the equity universe and the 63rd percentile in its sector. The trailing 12-month maximum drawdown of 40.01% corresponds to the 66th percentile overall and the 45th percentile in the industry.

Economic Moat ^Qas of 14 May 2024

With a Morningstar quantitative moat rating of None, the quantitative moat score for Pharma Mar falls at the 76th percentile in the healthcare sector and at the 71st in the equity coverage universe. The company has maintained its None quantitative moat rating since after 09/27/2023, when it was downgraded from Narrow.

We also assign a Strong quantitative financial health rating to Pharma Mar. The company's raw score on this metric, termed Distance to Default, ranks at the 90th percentile overall and 95th in the healthcare sector. Furthermore, this financial health rating has stayed Strong over the last year. Supporting these ratings are the company's book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield of 32.25%, ranks at the 30th percentile in the covered equity universe and at the 49th percentile among its peers. Meanwhile, its enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 0.80, falls at the 19th percentile in the universe and the 26th percentile in the healthcare sector.

Fundamentals as of 14 May 2024


Pharma Mar maintains earnings per share of 0.11. The company further earns a return on invested capital of 0.82%. The shares offer a dividend yield of 2.14%. These values are calculated over a trailing 12-month period.

As of last market close, Pharma Mar has a price-toearnings ratio of 302.33, falling below the 95th percentile in its sector (where a lower percentile means a lower ratio) and ranging between 18.58 and 510.33 over the past year.

Quantitative Equity Ratings

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The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analystdriven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. Please go to http://global.morningstar.com/ equitydisclosures for information about Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies.

ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10% Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

 $Very\ High\ -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

 $\ensuremath{\textit{Extreme}}\xspace -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Strong - assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. Last Close – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation**– Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Sustainalytics analyzes over 1,300 data points to assess a company's exposure to and management of ESG risks. In other words, ESG Risk Ratings measures a company's unmanaged ESG Risks represented as a quantitative score. Unmanaged Risk is measured on an open-ended scale starting at zero (no risk) with lower scores representing less unmanaged risk and, for 95% of cases, the unmanaged ESG Risk score is below 50.
