



Business Description

Technomeca Aerospace SA is an industrial and engineering company. It offers solutions in the design and definition of industrial processes and tooling, serial manufacture of aeronautics parts and automation and robotization of processes. The company's products offerings are Aero and Auto Tooling, Project Engineering, Serial Aeroparts Manufacturing, Thermoplastics tools, among others.

Valuation ^Qas of 26 Apr 2024

Technomeca Aerospace achieves a 3-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system. The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 0.91, in-line with the previous closing price of 0.93. The stock has been trading between a 19.92% discount and 10.51% premium to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 93rd percentile in the coverage universe and 88th percentile in the industrials sector (higher percentile indicates more undervalued).

The quantitative uncertainty rating for Technomeca Aerospace is Extreme.

Our quantitative star rating remains unchanged over the past year; the uncertainty rating remains unchanged over the same period as well.

The main drivers of the company's valuation and uncertainty are its earnings yield and drawdown. The earnings yield of 2.08% falls at the 46th percentile in the equity universe and the 33rd percentile in its sector. The trailing 12-month maximum drawdown of 0.00% corresponds to the 5th percentile overall and the 5th percentile in the industry.

Quantitatively, we believe Technomeca Aerospace

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has a Narrow economic moat. Its moat score of 0.97 corresponds to the 90th percentile in the industrials sector. Furthermore, this rating has not changed over the past year, while the company's moat score is near its maximum in this period.

The company also maintains a quantitative financial health rating of Strong. Its score sits at the 82nd percentile overall and the 84th percentile in the sector

Examining the company's financials and market statistics, we find these ratings are principally driven by its book value yield and annualized trailing 12-month volatility. The book value yield is 40.44%, sitting at the 37th percentile in the industrials sector. The company's annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 0.00%, corresponding to below the 5th percentile in both the equity coverage universe and sector.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.
