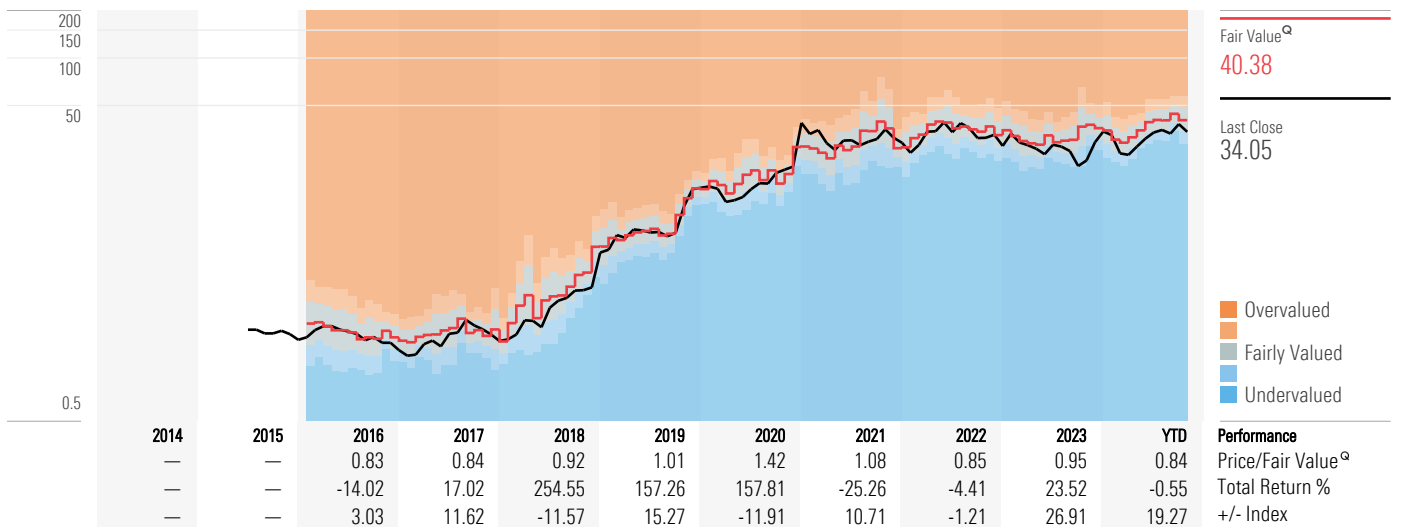

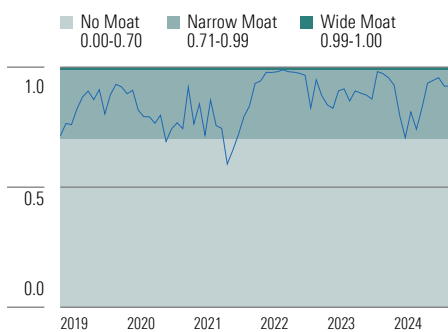

Business Description

Grenergy Renovables SA is a Spanish Independent Power Producer (IPP) that designs, develops, and executes renewable energy plants on a large scale. Its services are divided into different activities including the promotion, commercialization, and construction of renewable energy installations, the production and commercialization of electric energy as well as any complementary activities, and the management and operation of renewable energy installations. It operates in segments that include: Development and Construction which also generates key revenue for the company; Energy; Commercialization, and Services. Geographically, the company generates revenue from Chile, Mexico, Peru, Argentina, Colombia, Spain and other regions.

Valuation^Q as of 11 Oct 2024

Grenergy Renovables achieves a 4-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system. The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 42.10, above the previous closing price of 34.75. The stock has been trading between a 40.41% and 1.74% discount to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 66th percentile in the coverage universe and 59th percentile in the industrials sector. The quantitative uncertainty rating for Grenergy Renovables is High. Our quantitative star rating last differed from the current rating on 07/05/2024; the uncertainty rating last differed on 10/09/2024. The previous ratings were 3 and Very High, respectively. The main driver of the company's valuation and uncertainty is its EV-MV ratio. The enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 1.78 falls at the 84th percent-

ile in the equity universe and 84th in its sector.

Economic Moat^Q as of 11 Oct 2024

Quantitatively, we believe Grenergy Renovables has a Narrow economic moat. Its moat score of 0.93 corresponds to the 84th percentile in the industrials sector. Furthermore, this rating last differed from its previous rating of None on 05/24/2024, when the company's moat score fell from its maximum of 0.99 (score of 1 indicates greatest economic moat). The company also maintains a quantitative financial health rating of Moderate. Its score sits at the 23rd percentile overall and the 22nd percentile in the sector. Examining the company's financials and market statistics, we find these ratings are principally driven by its enterprise value and annualized trailing 12-month volatility. The enterprise value is 1.94 billion, sitting at the 68th percentile in the industrials sector. The company's annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 32.83%, corresponding to the 49th percentile in the equity coverage universe and the 55th percentile in the sector.

Fundamentals as of 11 Oct 2024

The earnings per share for Grenergy Renovables is 1.61. The company earns a return on invested capital of 6.74%, falling at the 52nd percentile in the industrials sector. The company did not report a dividend. We calculate the above figures over a trailing 12-month period. Examining valuation further, we find Grenergy Renovables holds a price-to-earnings ratio of 21.58, a figure greater than 58% of its sector peers.

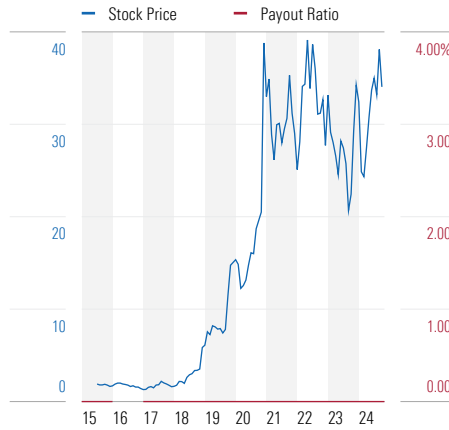

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Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings").

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%

Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

Extreme – the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Moderate – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health is between 0.2 and 0.7

Strong – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. **Last Close** – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation** – Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Sustainalytics analyzes over 1,300 data points to assess a company's exposure to and management of ESG risks. In other words, ESG Risk Ratings measures a company's unmanaged ESG Risks represented as a quantitative score.

Unmanaged Risk is measured on an open-ended scale starting at zero (no risk) with lower scores representing less unmanaged risk and, for 95% of cases, the unmanaged ESG Risk score is below 50.

Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk Categories (negligible, low, medium, high, severe). These risk categories are absolute, meaning that a 'high risk' assessment reflects a comparable degree

of unmanaged ESG risk across all subindustries covered.

The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale. Companies with Negligible Risk = 5 Globes, Low Risk = 4, Medium Risk = 3 Globes, High Risk = 2 Globes, Severe Risk = 1 Globe. For more information, please visit sustainalytics.com/esg-ratings/

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
