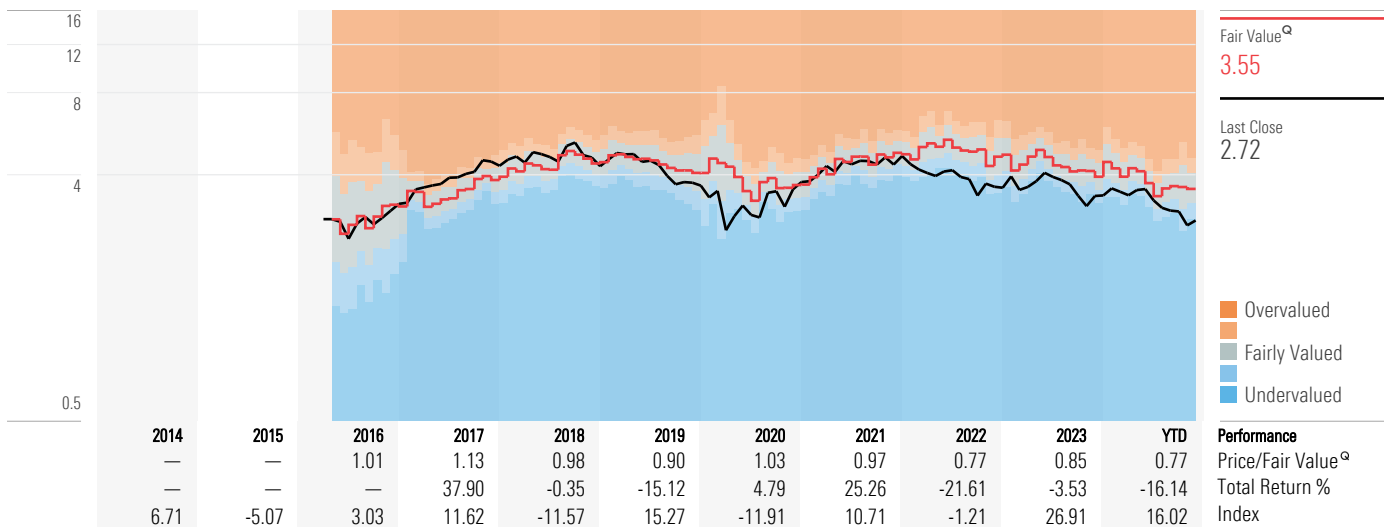

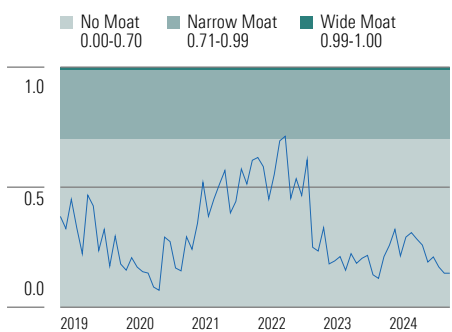

Business Description

Global Dominion Access SA provides multi-technical services and engineering solutions. The company provides its services and solutions to telecom, banking, education, and the healthcare industry. Its business activity is functioned through three segments namely 360 Projects, Sustainable Services and Stake in infrastructure segments. The group derives the majority of revenue from Sustainable Services which covers all those services required to perform maintenance (O&M) on infrastructures and in-house created processes, remaining committed to efficiency in the long term. The company geographically operates in Spain, The rest of Europe and Africa, America and Oceania.

The annualized trailing 12-month volatility of 19.48% corresponds to the 17th percentile overall and the 7th percentile in the industry.

Global Dominion Access achieves a 4-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system. The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 3.55, above the previous closing price of 2.72. The stock has been trading between a 28.03% and 5.47% discount to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 54th percentile in the coverage universe and 51st percentile in the technology sector. The quantitative uncertainty rating for Global Dominion Access is High. Our quantitative star rating last differed from the current rating on 08/02/2024; the uncertainty rating last differed on 11/05/2024. The previous ratings were 3 and Very High, respectively. The main drivers of the company's valuation and uncertainty are its earnings yield and volatility. The earnings yield of 10.42% falls at the 86th percentile in the equity universe and the 94th percentile in its

With a Morningstar quantitative moat rating of None, the quantitative moat score for Global Dominion Access falls at the 12th percentile in the technology sector and at the 16th in the equity coverage universe. The company has maintained its None quantitative moat rating for the last year. We also assign a Moderate quantitative financial health rating to Global Dominion Access. The company's raw score on this metric, termed Distance to Default, ranks at the 57th percentile overall and in the technology sector. Furthermore, this financial health rating has stayed Moderate over the last year. Supporting these ratings are the company's book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield of 72.63%, ranks at the 59th percentile in the covered equity universe and at the 75th percentile among its peers. Meanwhile, its enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 1.49, falls at the 77th percentile in the universe and the 88th percentile in the technology sector.

Fundamentals as of 13 Nov 2024

The earnings per share for Global Dominion Access is 0.25. The company earns a return on invested capital of 8.28%, falling at the 65th percentile in the technology sector. The firm maintains a dividend yield of 3.75%. We calculate the above figures over a trailing 12-month period. Examining valuation further, we find Global Dominion Access holds a price-to-earnings ratio of 9.59, a figure greater than 10% of its sector peers.

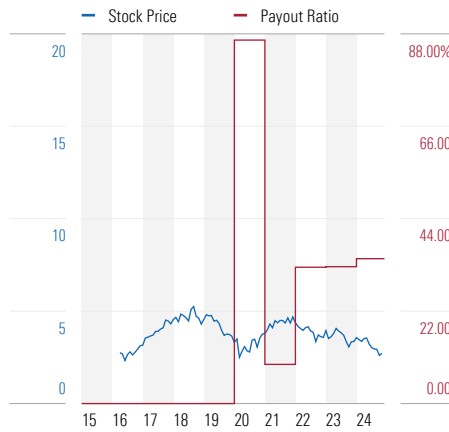

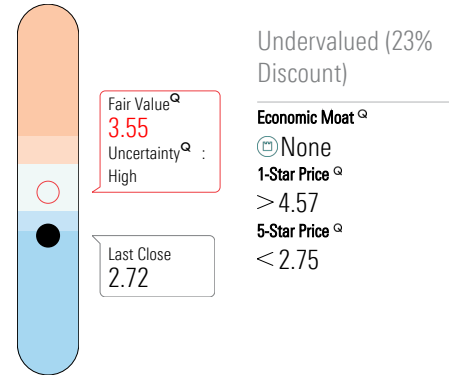

Quantitative Equity Report Overview

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Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings").

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%

Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

Extreme – the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Moderate – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health is between 0.2 and 0.7

Strong – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. **Last Close** – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation** – Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Sustainalytics analyzes over 1,300 data points to assess a company's exposure to and management of ESG risks. In other words, ESG Risk Ratings measures a company's unmanaged ESG Risks represented as a quantitative score. Unmanaged Risk is measured on an open-ended scale starting at zero (no risk) with lower scores representing less unmanaged risk and, for 95% of cases, the unmanaged ESG Risk score is below 50.

Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk Categories (negligible, low, medium, high, severe). These risk categories are absolute, meaning that a 'high risk' assessment reflects a comparable degree

of unmanaged ESG risk across all subindustries covered.

The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale.
