
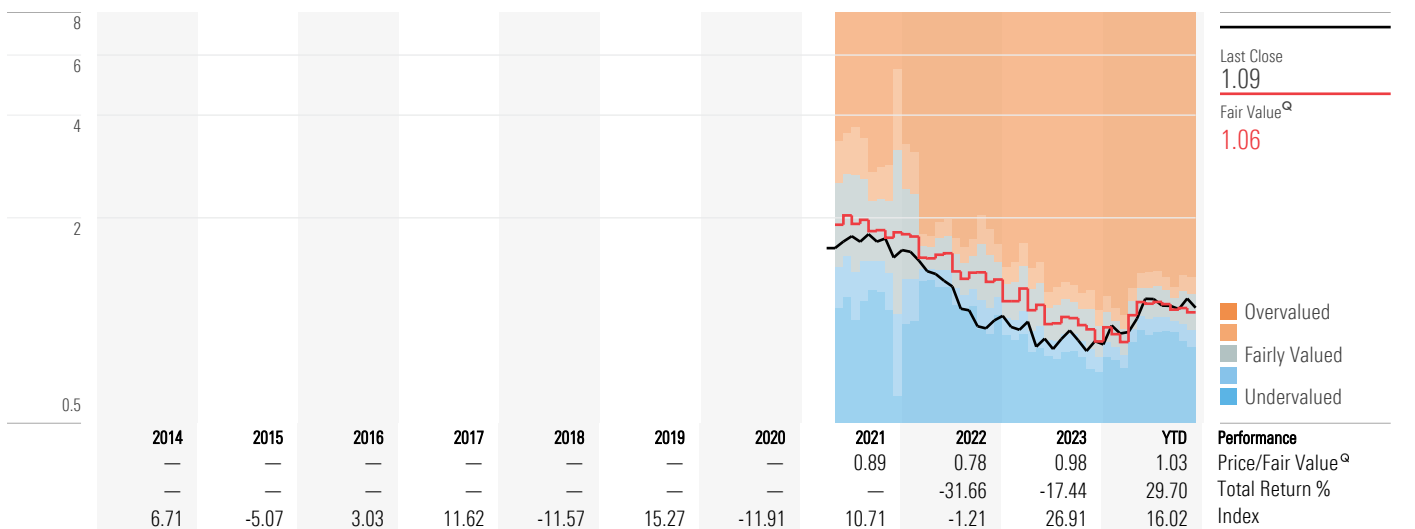

Business Description

Linea Directa Aseguradora SA is engaged in insurance and reinsurance activities in the motor, home, and other non-life segments. The company has five operating segments; The motor segment which derives maximum revenue, includes private motor insurance and motorbike insurance, The home segment includes multi-risk home insurance products with theft damage, civil liability, fire damage, aesthetic damage, etc, The health segment includes health insurance products under the Vivaz brand, The other insurance segment includes various products with stand-alone policies that are not linked to motor, home or health insurance, such as travel insurance for holders of credit cards and wellness insurance, and The other activities segment mainly relates to auxiliary insurance businesses and commissions.

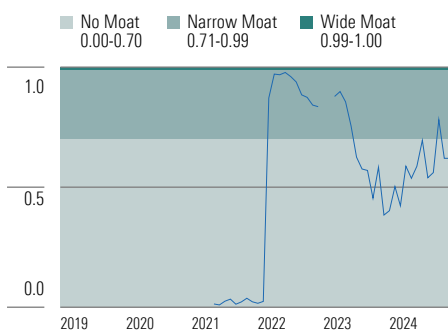
We examine the financials and market statistics for Linea Directa Aseguradora to determine these ratings. Its earnings yield is 2.38% and its annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 21.03%. These fall at the 48th and 21st percentiles in the equity universe and at the 28th and 38th in the financial services sector, respectively.

Economic Moat ^Q as of 12 Nov 2024

Morningstar maintains a quantitative moat rating of None on the company. The firm's quantitative moat score of 0.62 sits at the 62nd percentile in the financial services sector. This is a decrease from 0.82, the maximum of its moat scores over the past year. The quantitative financial health rating for Linea Directa Aseguradora is Strong. Its financial health score, termed Distance to Default, sits at the 86th percentile in the universe and 49th percentile in the sector.

The significant drivers of these ratings are the company's enterprise value and annualized trailing 12-month volatility. The enterprise value for Linea Directa Aseguradora is 1.20 billion, and its annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 21.03%. They sit at the 66th and 21st percentile in the global equity universe, respectively.

Morningstar affirms a 3-star quantitative rating for Linea Directa Aseguradora. We calculate this outcome using the company's underlying model-driven valuation and uncertainty scores.

The stock's last closing price was 1.09, in-line with its Quantitative Fair Value estimate of 1.06. The stock has been trading between a 11.07% discount and 7.49% premium to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's price to fair value ratio is at the 90th percentile in our global equity coverage universe for this methodology and at the 91st percentile relative to its peers in the financial services sector.

Linea Directa Aseguradora furthermore holds a High quantitative uncertainty rating.

The company's quantitative star rating dates to after 11/22/2023, before which it was 4-star. Similarly, the firm's uncertainty rating changed from Medium to High after 10/04/2024.


Fundamentals as of 13 Nov 2024

The earnings per share for Linea Directa Aseguradora is 0.03. The firm maintains a dividend yield of 1.19%. We calculate the above figures over a trailing 12-month period.

Examining valuation further, we find Linea Directa Aseguradora holds a price-to-earnings ratio of 41.98, a figure greater than 89% of its sector peers. The company's price-to-free cash flow ratio is 43.04, greater than 89% of its sector peers. These

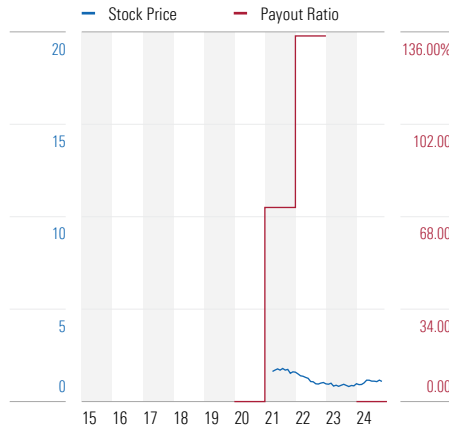

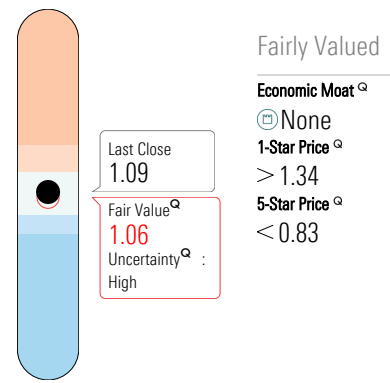

Quantitative Equity Report Overview

The quantitative report on equities consists of data, statistics and quantitative equity ratings on equity securities. Morningstar, Inc.'s quantitative equity ratings are forward looking and are generated by a statistical model that is based on Morningstar Inc.'s analyst-driven equity ratings and quantitative statistics. Given the nature of the quantitative report and the quantitative ratings, there is no one analyst in which a given report is attributed to; however, Mr. Lee Davidson, Head of Quantitative Research for Morningstar, Inc., is responsible for overseeing the methodology that supports the quantitative equity ratings used in this report. As an employee of Morningstar, Inc., Mr. Davidson is guided by Morningstar, Inc.'s Code of Ethics and Personal Securities Trading Policy in carrying out his responsibilities.

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Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings").

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i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. Please go to <http://global.morningstar.com/equitydisclosures> for information about Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies.

ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%

Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

Extreme – the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Moderate – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health is between 0.2 and 0.7

Strong – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. **Last Close** – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation** – Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Sustainalytics analyzes over 1,300 data points to assess a company's exposure to and management of ESG risks. In other words, ESG Risk Ratings measures a company's unmanaged ESG Risks represented as a quantitative score. Unmanaged Risk is measured on an open-ended scale starting at zero (no risk) with lower scores representing less unmanaged risk and, for 95% of cases, the unmanaged ESG Risk score is below 50.

Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk Categories (negligible, low, medium, high, severe). These risk categories are absolute, meaning that a 'high risk' assessment reflects a comparable degree

of unmanaged ESG risk across all subindustries covered.

The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale.
