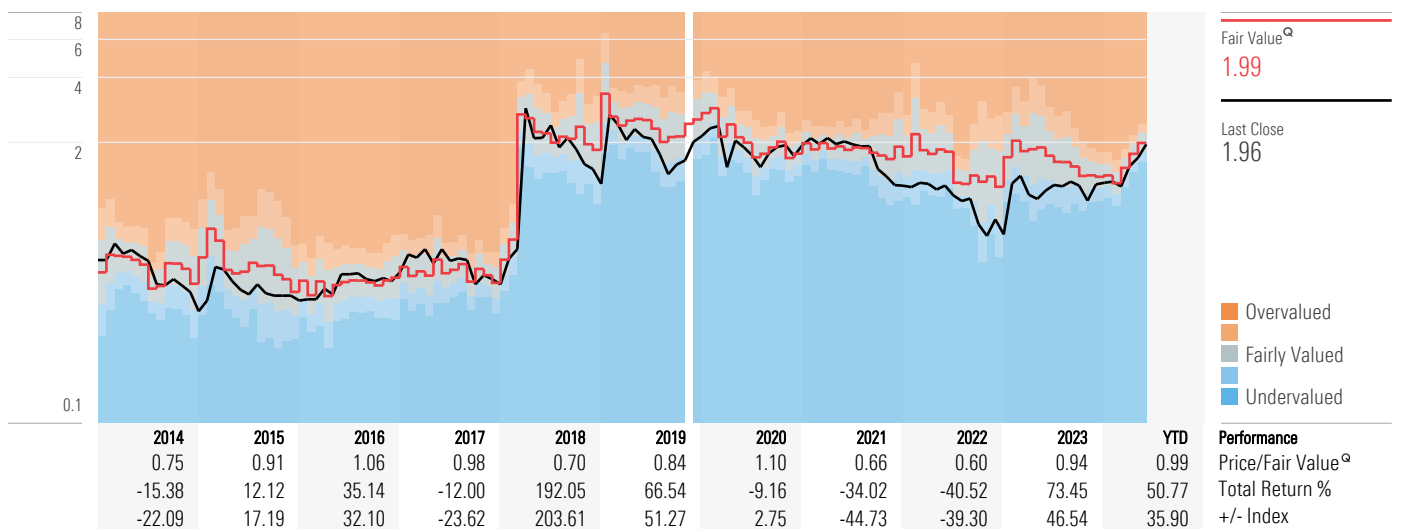

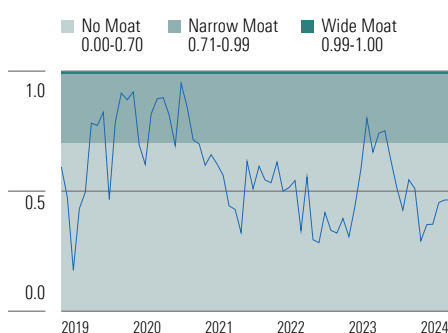

Business Description

Audax Renovables SA is engaged in the development of renewable energy for generating electricity. The company is mainly focused on developing wind energy. The group's projects are located in Spain, France, Panama, Germany, and Poland. The majority of the revenue is generated from Spain and Portugal.

Valuation^Q as of 17 May 2024

Morningstar maintains a 3-star quantitative star rating for Audax Renovables, derived from the firm's valuation and uncertainty scores. The company's shares last closed at 1.93, in-line with our quantitative fair value estimate of 1.87. These shares have traded between a 41.56% discount and 3.19% premium to their fair value estimate over the past year. In Morningstar's equity coverage universe for this methodology, the company's valuation rating lands at the 92nd percentile; in the utilities sector, the firm's score lies at the 95th percentile (meaning the shares are more undervalued than 95% of stocks in the sector). Furthermore, Audax Renovables maintains a quantitative valuation uncertainty rating of High.

The company has held this star rating since the previous rating of 4, which was last assigned on 11/24/2023. The uncertainty rating for Audax Renovables has remained High since the previous rating of Very High, which was last assigned on 04/01/2024.

The key factors behind these ratings are the company's earnings yield and EV-MV ratio. The earnings yield is 3.42%, and its maximum enterprise value-to-market value ratio is 1.85. The earnings yield falls at the 35th percentile in the utilities sector while the EV-MV ratio is at the 40th percentile. Over the past year, the company's earnings yield has been between 0.49% and 5.16%; its EV-MV ra-

tio has ranged between 1.34 and 1.85.

Economic Moat^Q as of 17 May 2024

With a Morningstar quantitative moat rating of None, the quantitative moat score for Audax Renovables falls at the 47th percentile in the utilities sector and at the 51st in the equity coverage universe. The company has maintained its None quantitative moat rating since after 08/24/2023, when it was downgraded from Narrow.

We also assign a Moderate quantitative financial health rating to Audax Renovables. The company's raw score on this metric, termed Distance to Default, ranks at the 48th percentile overall and 54th in the utilities sector. Furthermore, this financial health rating has stayed Moderate over the last year.


Supporting these ratings are the company's enterprise value and annualized trailing 12-month volatility. The enterprise value of 1.27 billion, ranks at the 67th percentile in the covered equity universe and at the 41st percentile among its peers. Meanwhile, its annualized trailing 12-month volatility of 23.83%, falls at the 31st percentile in the universe and the 49th percentile in the utilities sector.

Fundamentals as of 17 May 2024

The earnings per share for Audax Renovables is 0.07. The company earns a return on invested capital of 6.16%, falling at the 60th percentile in the utilities sector. The company did not report a dividend. We calculate the above figures over a trailing 12-month period.

Examining valuation further, we find Audax Renovables holds a price-to-earnings ratio of 29.21, a figure greater than 81% of its sector peers. The company's price-to-free cash flow ratio is 7.75, greater than 34% of its sector peers. These values are cal-

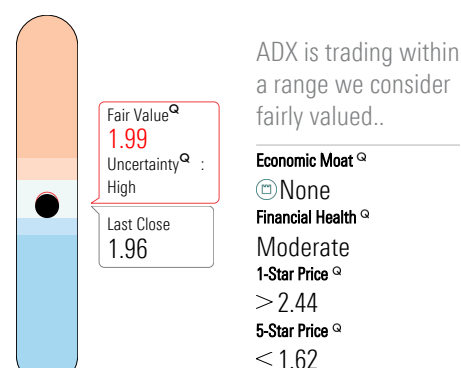

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Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings").

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%

Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

Extreme – the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Moderate – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health is between 0.2 and 0.7

Strong – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. **Last Close** – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation** – Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Sustainalytics analyzes over 1,300 data points to assess a company's exposure to and management of ESG risks. In other words, ESG Risk Ratings measures a company's unmanaged ESG Risks represented as a quantitative score. Unmanaged Risk is measured on an open-ended scale starting at zero (no risk) with lower scores representing less unmanaged risk and, for 95% of cases, the unmanaged ESG Risk score is below 50.

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The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale. Companies with Negligible Risk = 5 Globes, Low Risk = 4, Medium Risk = 3 Globes, High Risk = 2 Globes, Severe Risk = 1 Globe. For more information, please visit sustainalytics.com/esg-ratings/

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
