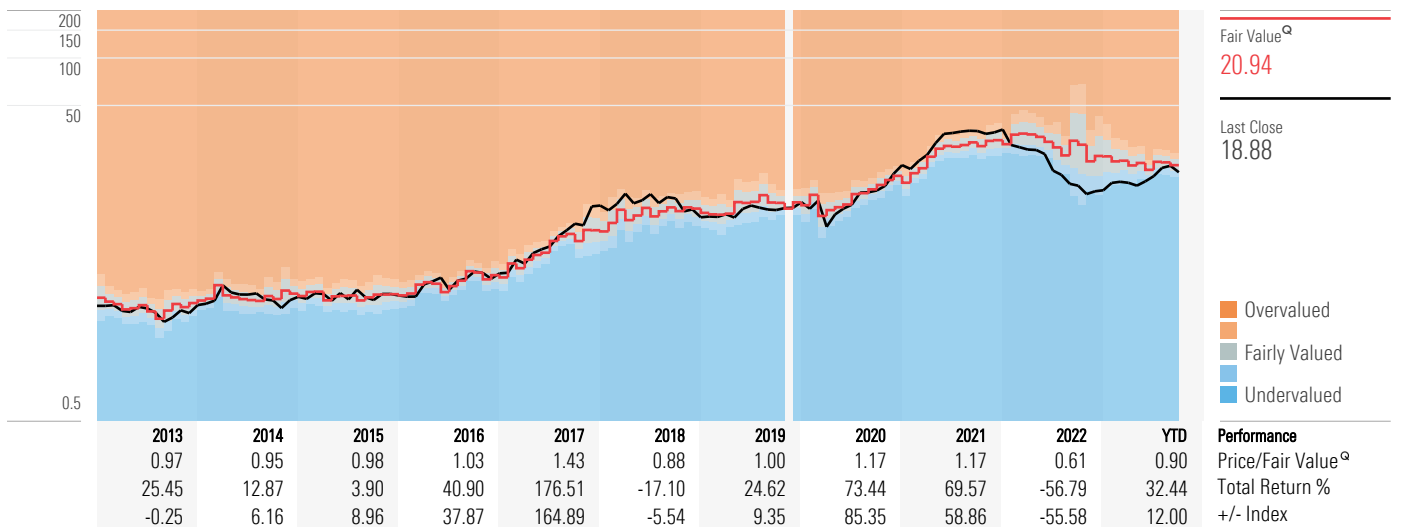

Business Description

Fluidra SA is engaged in the business of pool and wellness and Irrigation, Industrial and Others. The company is responsible for manufacturing and distributing all the components required for the construction, renovation, improvement and maintenance of residential and commercial pools. Also, in some southern European countries, the company supplements its core pool and wellness business with irrigation and landscaping accessories for gardens that are often adjacent to pools. The Business Divisions of the company are EMEA, North America and APAC.

Valuation ^Q as of 21 Sep 2023

Morningstar maintains a 3-star quantitative star rating for Fluidra, derived from the firm's valuation and uncertainty scores.

The company's shares last closed at 18.88, below our quantitative fair value estimate of 20.94. These shares have traded between a 52.54% and 4.01% discount to their fair value estimate over the past year. In Morningstar's equity coverage universe for this methodology, the company's valuation rating lands at the 85th percentile; in the industrials sector, the firm's score lies at the 75th percentile (meaning the shares are more undervalued than 75% of stocks in the sector).

Furthermore, Fluidra maintains a quantitative valuation uncertainty rating of High.

The company has held this star rating since the previous rating of 4, which was last assigned on 08/02/2023. The uncertainty rating for Fluidra has remained High since the previous rating of Medium, which was last assigned on 08/18/2023.

The key factor behind these ratings is the company's enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 1.39 which falls above the 73rd percentile in the industrials sector. Over the past year, the company's

EV-MV ratio has been between 1.34 and 1.55.

Economic Moat ^Q as of 20 Sep 2023

With a Morningstar quantitative moat rating of None, the quantitative moat score for Fluidra falls at the 62nd percentile in the industrials sector and at the 61st in the equity coverage universe. The company has maintained its None quantitative moat rating since after 09/05/2023, when it was downgraded from Narrow.

We also assign a Moderate quantitative financial health rating to Fluidra. The company's raw score on this metric, termed Distance to Default, ranks at the 32nd percentile overall and 31st in the industrials sector. Furthermore, this financial health rating has stayed Moderate over the last year.


Supporting these ratings are the company's book value yield and annualized trailing 12-month volatility. The book value yield of 44.90%, ranks at the 39th percentile in the covered equity universe and at the 40th percentile among its peers. Meanwhile, its annualized trailing 12-month volatility of 28.73%, falls at the 44th percentile in the universe and the 52nd percentile in the industrials sector.

Fundamentals as of 20 Sep 2023

Fluidra reports earnings per share of 0.52. Its return on invested capital is 4.68%. The company maintains a dividend yield of 3.71%, paying out 140.17% of earnings. These values are calculated over a trailing 12-month period.

As of last market close, Fluidra has a price-to-earnings ratio of 33.97, falling at the 79th percentile in its sector (where a lower percentile means a lower ratio) and ranging between 9.53 and 39.68 over the past year. The company's price-to-free cash flow ratio is 19.22, falling at the 58th percentile in its sector and ranging between 19.22 and 368.18 over

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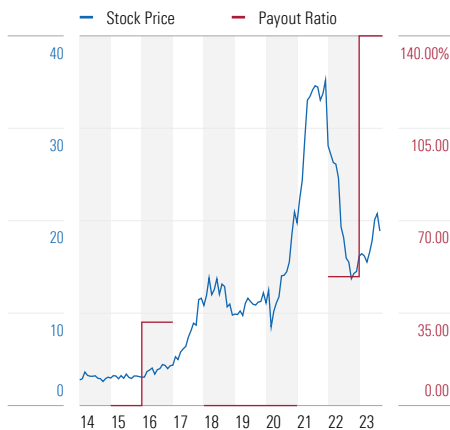

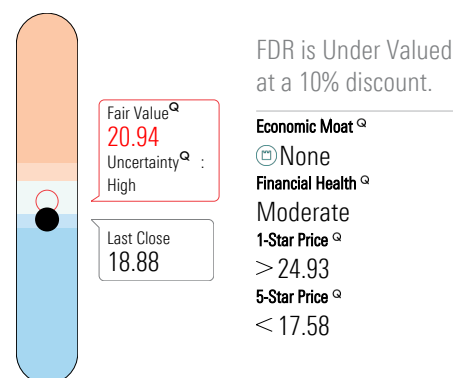

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Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings").

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

- i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. Please go to <http://global.morningstar.com/equitydisclosures> for information about Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies.
- ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.
 - Narrow** – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.
 - Wide** – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.
 - None** – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

- iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

- iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%

Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

Extreme – the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

- v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Moderate – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health is between 0.2 and 0.7

Strong – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

- i. **Last Close** – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.
- ii. **Quantitative Valuation** – Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk

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The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale. Companies with Negligible Risk = 5 Globes, Low Risk = 4, Medium Risk = 3 Globes, High Risk = 2 Globes, Severe Risk = 1 Globe. For more information, please visit sustainalytics.com/esg-ratings/

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
