



Business Description

NH Hotel Group SA is a Spanish owner and operator of hotels. The company reports turnover across four segments: hotel occupancy, catering, meeting rooms, and rentals & other services. Hotel occupancy generates the majority of its income. Its geographical segments include BUSE (Southern Europe), which includes Italy, Spain, Portugal, France, Andorra, Tunisia, and the USA; BUNE segment includes Central Europe & Benelux; and BUAM, which includes Latin America, which includes: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Cuba, Ecuador, Haiti, Mexico and Uruguay.

Valuation ^Qas of 3 May 2024

NH Hotel Group achieves a 4-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system.

The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 4.50, above the previous closing price of 4.13. The stock has been trading between a 32.53% and 4.93% discount to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 80th percentile in the coverage universe and 81st percentile in the consumer cyclical sector (higher percentile indicates more undervalued).

The quantitative uncertainty rating for NH Hotel Group is High.

Our quantitative star rating last differed from the current rating on 04/02/2024; the uncertainty rating last differed on 04/01/2024. The previous ratings were 3 and Very High, respectively.

The main drivers of the company's valuation and uncertainty are its earnings yield and volatility. The earnings yield of 7.13% falls at the 76th percentile in the equity universe and the 73rd percentile in its sector. The annualized trailing 12-month volatility of 16.61% corresponds to the 12th percentile over-

all and the 10th percentile in the industry.

Economic Moat as of 3 May 2024

With a Morningstar quantitative moat rating of None, the quantitative moat score for NH Hotel Group falls at the 49th percentile in the consumer cyclical sector and at the 46th in the equity coverage universe. The company has maintained its None quantitative moat rating since after 08/17/2023, when it was downgraded from Narrow.

We also assign a Moderate quantitative financial health rating to NH Hotel Group. The company's raw score on this metric, termed Distance to Default, ranks at the 50th percentile overall and 56th in the consumer cyclical sector. Furthermore, this financial health rating has stayed Moderate over the last year.

Supporting these ratings are the company's book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield of 53.25%, ranks at the 46th percentile overall and among its peers. Meanwhile, its enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 2.24, falls at the 89th percentile in the universe and the 84th percentile in the consumer cyclical sector.

Fundamentals as of 3 May 2024

The earnings per share for NH Hotel Group is 0.29. The company earns a return on invested capital of 5.82%, falling at the 51st percentile in the consumer cyclical sector. The company did not report a dividend. We calculate the above figures over a trailing 12-month period.

Examining valuation further, we find NH Hotel Group holds a price-to-earnings ratio of 14.01, a figure greater than 39% of its sector peers. The company's price-to-free cash flow ratio is 3.79, greater than 12% of its sector peers. These values are calculated using the stock's price at last market






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Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings).

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

- i. Quantitative Fair Value Estimate: Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. - ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide — assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None — assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

- iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%
Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15%
but greater than 10%

 $\bar{\text{\textbf{High}}}$ — the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

Extreme – the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak — assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Moderate — assigned when Quantitative Financial Health is between 0.2

and 0.7

Strong – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

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- i. Last Close Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.
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Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value
