


Business Description

NH Hotel Group SA is a Spanish owner and operator of hotels. The company reports turnover across four segments: hotel occupancy, catering, meeting rooms, and rentals & other services. Hotel occupancy generates the majority of its income. Its geographical segments include BUSE (Southern Europe), which includes Italy, Spain, Portugal, France, Andorra, Tunisia, and the USA; BUNE segment includes Central Europe & Benelux; and BUAM, which includes Latin America, which includes: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Cuba, Ecuador, Haiti, Mexico and Uruguay.

Valuation ^Qas of 1 May 2024

Morningstar maintains a 4-star quantitative star rating for NH Hotel Group, derived from the firm's valuation and uncertainty scores.

The company's shares last closed at 4.10, below our quantitative fair value estimate of 4.58. These shares have traded between a 32.53% and 4.93% discount to their fair value estimate over the past year. In Morningstar's equity coverage universe for this methodology, the company's valuation rating lands at the 76th percentile; in the consumer cyclical sector, the firm's score lies at the 80th percentile (meaning the shares are more undervalued than 80% of stocks in the sector).

Furthermore, NH Hotel Group maintains a quantitative valuation uncertainty rating of High.

The company has held this star rating since the previous rating of 3, which was last assigned on 04/02/2024. The uncertainty rating for NH Hotel Group has remained High since the previous rating of Very High, which was last assigned on 04/01/2024.

The key factors behind these ratings are the company's earnings yield and volatility. The earnings yield is 7.17%, and its maximum annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 31.79%. The earnings yield falls at the 73rd percentile in the consumer cyclical sector while the volatility is at the 11th percentile. Over the past year, the company's earnings yield has been between 0.09% and 9.68%; its volatility has ranged between 15.69% and 31.79%.

Economic Moat ^Qas of 1 May 2024

With a Morningstar quantitative moat rating of None, the quantitative moat score for NH Hotel Group falls at the 54th percentile in the consumer cyclical sector and at the 51st in the equity coverage universe. The company has maintained its None quantitative moat rating since after 08/17/ 2023, when it was downgraded from Narrow.

We also assign a Moderate quantitative financial health rating to NH Hotel Group. The company's raw score on this metric, termed Distance to Default, ranks at the 49th percentile overall and 55th in the consumer cyclical sector. Furthermore, this financial health rating has stayed Moderate over the last year.


Supporting these ratings are the company's book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield of 53.57%, ranks at the 46th percentile overall and among its peers. Meanwhile, its enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 2.25, falls at the 89th percentile in the universe and the 84th percentile in the consumer cyclical sector.

Fundamentals as of 1 May 2024

NH Hotel Group reports earnings per share of 0.29. Its return on invested capital is 5.82%. These values are calculated over a trailing 12-month period. As of last market close, NH Hotel Group has a price-to-earnings ratio of 13.95, falling at the 38th percentile in its sector (where a lower percentile means a lower ratio) and ranging between 10.33



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and 20.28 over the past year. The company's priceto-free cash flow ratio is 3.78, falling at the 12th percentile in its sector and ranging between 3.01 and 4.28 over the past year.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10% Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

 $Very\ High\ -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

 $\ensuremath{\textit{Extreme}}\xspace -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Strong - assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. Last Close – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation**— Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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
