



Business Description

Solaria Energia y Medio Ambiente SA is a solar photovoltaic (PV) power generation company. It is also engaged in the solar power plant custom operation and maintenance services and development and management of PV projects. The company owns, manages and operates PV plants in Spain, Italy, Uruguay, Greece and Brazil.

Valuation as of 3 May 2024

Morningstar affirms a 3-star quantitative rating for Solaria Energia y Medio. We calculate this outcome using the company's underlying model-driven valuation and uncertainty scores.

The stock's last closing price was 9.87, a discount of 27.22% to its Quantitative Fair Value estimate of 13.55. The stock has been trading between a 29.57% discount and 15.39% premium to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's price to fair value ratio is at the 44th percentile in our global equity coverage universe for this methodology and at the 32nd percentile relative to its peers in the utilities sector.

Solaria Energia y Medio furthermore holds a Very High quantitative uncertainty rating.

The company's quantitative star rating dates to after 03/08/2024, before which it was 4-star. Similarly, the firm's uncertainty rating changed from High to Very High after 03/26/2024.

We examine the financials and market statistics for Solaria Energia y Medio to determine these ratings. Its earnings yield is 8.72% and its annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 31.94%. These fall at the 82nd and 49th percentiles in the equity universe and at the 76th and 67th in the utilities sector, respectively.

Economic Moat ^Qas of 3 May 2024

Morningstar maintains a Narrow quantitative moat

rating on the company. The firm's quantitative moat score of 0.76 sits at the 73rd percentile in the utilities sector. This is a decrease from 0.91, the maximum of its moat scores over the past year.

The quantitative financial health rating for Solaria Energia y Medio is Moderate. Its financial health score, termed Distance to Default, sits at the 22nd percentile in both the universe and sector.

The significant drivers of these ratings are the company's enterprise value and annualized trailing 12-month volatility. The enterprise value for Solaria Energia y Medio is 2.38 billion, and its annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 31.94%. They sit at the 74th and 49th percentile in the global equity universe, respectively.

Fundamentals as of 3 May 2024

Solaria Energia y Medio maintains earnings per share of 0.86. The company further earns a return on invested capital of 9.51%. These values are calculated over a trailing 12-month period.

As of last market close, Solaria Energia y Medio has a price-to-earnings ratio of 11.47, falling below the 34th percentile in its sector (where a lower percentile means a lower ratio) and ranging between 10.97 and 22.69 over the past year.






Given the nature of the quantitative report and the quantitative ratings, there is no one analyst in which a given report is attributed to; however, Mr. Lee Davidson, Head of Quantitative Research for Morningstar, Inc., is responsible for overseeing the methodology that supports the quantitative equity ratings used in this report. As an employee of Morningstar, Inc., Mr. Davidson is guided by Morningstar, Inc.'s Code of Ethics and Personal Securities Trading Policy in carrying out his responsibilities.

Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings).

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

- i. Quantitative Fair Value Estimate: Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. - ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide — assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None — assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

- iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%
Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15%
but greater than 10%

 $\bar{\text{\textbf{High}}}$ — the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

Extreme – the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak — assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Moderate — assigned when Quantitative Financial Health is between 0.2

and 0.7

Strong - assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

- i. Last Close Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.
- Quantitative Valuation— Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's Last Price and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate

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Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk Categories (negligible, low, medium, high, severe). These risk categories are absolute, meaning that a 'high risk' assessment reflects a comparable degree



of unmanaged ESG risk across all subindustries covered.

The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale.
