


Business Description

Prim SA is engaged in the provision of hospital supplies. The company is in a hospital and orthopedic supplies and materials for physiotherapy, thalassotherapy, thermal therapy, rehabilitation, geriatrics, as well as daily living aids. Prim work across a division of healthcare units such as Operating Theatres; Pain Management Centres; Plastic Surgery; Endosurgery and Cardiovascular.

Valuation ^Qas of 3 May 2024

Prim achieves a 3-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system.

The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 11.59, above the previous closing price of 10.05. The stock has been trading between a 26.08% and 7.01% discount to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 72nd percentile in the coverage universe and 80th percentile in the healthcare sector (higher percentile indicates more undervalued).

The quantitative uncertainty rating for Prim is High. Our quantitative star rating remains unchanged over the past year; the uncertainty rating last differed on 04/29/2024, when it was Very High.

The main drivers of the company's valuation and uncertainty are its earnings yield and volatility. The earnings yield of 7.36% falls at the 77th percentile in the equity universe and the 94th percentile in its sector. The annualized trailing 12-month volatility of 18.47% corresponds to the 17th percentile overall and the 9th percentile in the industry.

Economic Moat ^Qas of 3 May 2024

Quantitatively, we do not believe Prim has an economic moat. Its moat score of 0.66 corresponds to the 74th percentile in the healthcare sector. Furthermore, this rating last differed from its previous rating of Narrow on 04/29/2024, when the company's moat score fell from its maximum of 0.71 (score of 1 indicates greatest economic moat).

The company also maintains a quantitative financial health rating of Strong. Its score sits at the 75th percentile overall and the 81st percentile in the sector.

Examining the company's financials and market statistics, we find these ratings are principally driven by its book value yield and annualized trailing 12-month volatility. The book value yield is 73.59%, sitting at the 76th percentile in the healthcare sector. The company's annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 18.47%, corresponding to the 17th percentile in the equity coverage universe and the 9th percentile in the sector.

Fundamentals as of 3 May 2024

The earnings per share for Prim is 0.74. The company earns a return on invested capital of 8.85%, falling at the 81st percentile in the healthcare sector. The firm maintains a dividend yield of 2.17%. We calculate the above figures over a trailing 12month period.

Examining valuation further, we find Prim holds a price-to-earnings ratio of 13.51, a figure greater than 18% of its sector peers.



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The quantitative report on equities consists of data, statistics and quantitative equity ratings on equity securities. Morningstar, Inc.'s quantitative equity ratings are forward looking and are generated by a statistical model that is based on Morningstar Inc.'s analyst-driven equity ratings and quantitative statistics. Given the nature of the quantitative report and the quantitative ratings, there is no one analyst in which a given report is attributed to; however, Mr. Lee Davidson, Head of Quantitative Research for Morningstar, Inc., is responsible for overseeing the methodology that supports the quantitative equity ratings used in this report. As an employee of Morningstar, Inc., Mr. Davidson is guided by Morningstar, Inc.'s Code of Ethics and Personal Securities Trading Policy in carrying out his responsibilities.

Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings).

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analystdriven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. Please go to http://global.morningstar.com/ equitydisclosures for information about Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies.

ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10% Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

 $Very\ High\ -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

 $\ensuremath{\textit{Extreme}}\xspace -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Strong - assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. Last Close – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation**– Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.
