



Business Description

Realia Business SA is a real estate company. It is mainly engaged in the promotion, management, and operation of all kinds of real estate assets. Its areas of activity include property, through the development and lease of its own offices and shopping centers, the development of housing and land management. In addition, the company holds a diversified portfolio of tenants, including great international firms of high solvency, and several public institutions. It has two reportable segments: Sale of property developments and land consisting of the majority of the revenue and followed by Property rentals segment.

Valuation as of 17 May 2024

Realia Business achieves a 4-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system.

The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 1.17, above the previous closing price of 1.02. The stock has been trading between a 17.27% and 3.51% discount to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 69th percentile in the coverage universe and 80th percentile in the real estate sector (higher percentile indicates more undervalued).

The quantitative uncertainty rating for Realia Business is High.

Our quantitative star rating last differed from the current rating on 04/02/2024; the uncertainty rating last differed on 01/01/2024. The previous ratings were 3 and Very High, respectively.

The main drivers of the company's valuation and uncertainty are its EV-MV ratio and volatility. The enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 1.63 falls at the 81st percentile in the equity universe and the 46th percentile in its sector. The annualized

trailing 12-month volatility of 13.34% corresponds to the 7th percentile overall and the 13th percentile in the industry.

Economic Moat as of 17 May 2024

Quantitatively, we do not believe Realia Business has an economic moat. Its moat score of 0.21 corresponds to the 32nd percentile in the real estate sector. Furthermore, this rating last differed from its previous rating of Narrow on 02/27/2024, when the company's moat score fell from its maximum of 0.85 (score of 1 indicates greatest economic moat). The company also maintains a quantitative financial health rating of Moderate. Its score sits at the 62nd percentile overall and the 77th percentile in the sector.

Examining the company's financials and market statistics, we find these ratings are principally driven by its book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield is 141.12%, sitting at the 64th percentile in the real estate sector. The company's enterprise value-to-market value ratio is 1.63, corresponding to the 81st percentile in the equity coverage universe and the 46th percentile in the sector.

Fundamentals as of 17 May 2024


Realia Business reports earnings per share of 0.03. Its return on invested capital is 2.65%. The company maintains a dividend yield of 4.9%, paying out 166.67% of earnings. These values are calculated over a trailing 12-month period.


As of last market close, Realia Business has a price-to-earnings ratio of 34, falling at the 76th percentile in its sector (where a lower percentile means a lower ratio) and ranging between 14.17 and 38.27 over the past year. The company's price-to-free cash flow ratio is 12.07, falling at the 47th

Quantitative Equity Report Overview

The quantitative report on equities consists of data, statistics and quantitative equity ratings on equity securities. Morningstar, Inc.'s quantitative equity ratings are forward looking and are generated by a statistical model that is based on Morningstar Inc.'s analyst-driven equity ratings and quantitative statistics. Given the nature of the quantitative report and the quantitative ratings, there is no one analyst in which a given report is attributed to; however, Mr. Lee Davidson, Head of Quantitative Research for Morningstar, Inc., is responsible for overseeing the methodology that supports the quantitative equity ratings used in this report. As an employee of Morningstar, Inc., Mr. Davidson is guided by Morningstar, Inc.'s Code of Ethics and Personal Securities Trading Policy in carrying out his responsibilities.

Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings).

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

- i. Quantitative Fair Value Estimate: Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. Please go to http://global.morningstar.com/equitydisclosures for information about Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies.
- ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide — assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None — assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

- iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%
Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15%
but greater than 10%

 $\bar{\text{\textbf{High}}}$ — the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.
