


Business Description

Tecnicas Reunidas SA is a general contracting company. It engages in engineering, design and construction of industrial facilities for international customers including principal national oil companies and multinational companies. The firm's majority of business is focused on large turnkey industrial projects and it also offers engineering, management, start-up and operating services for industrial plants. Its business areas are oil and gas, power, infrastructures and industries. The company mainly operates in Spain, Middle East, Latin America, Asia and the Mediterranean region.

Valuation ^Qas of 2 May 2024

Morningstar affirms a 3-star quantitative rating for Tecnicas Reunidas. We calculate this outcome using the company's underlying model-driven valuation and uncertainty scores.

The stock's last closing price was 9.31, a discount of 13.13% to its Quantitative Fair Value estimate of 10.72. This discount has ranged between 32.96% and 7.18% over the past year. The stock's price to fair value ratio is at the 74th percentile in our global equity coverage universe for this methodology and at the 60th percentile relative to its peers in the industrials sector.

Tecnicas Reunidas furthermore holds a High quantitative uncertainty rating.

The company's quantitative star rating dates to after 02/19/2024, before which it was 4-star. Similarly, the firm's uncertainty rating changed from Very High to High after 04/05/2024.

We examine the financials and market statistics for Tecnicas Reunidas to determine these ratings. Its earnings yield is 9.45% and falls at the 84th percentile in the equity universe and at the 82nd percentile in the industrials sector.

Economic Moat ^Qas of 2 May 2024

With a Morningstar quantitative moat rating of None, the quantitative moat score for Tecnicas Reunidas falls at the 58th percentile in the industrials sector and at the 65th in the equity coverage universe. The company has maintained its None quantitative moat rating since after 07/26/2023, when it was downgraded from Narrow.

We also assign a Strong quantitative financial health rating to Tecnicas Reunidas. The company's raw score on this metric, termed Distance to Default, ranks at the 86th percentile overall and 88th in the industrials sector. Furthermore, this financial health rating most recently changed from Moderate after 01/08/2024.

Supporting these ratings are the company's book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield of 43.17%, ranks at the 39th percentile overall and among its peers. Meanwhile, its enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 0.82, falls at the 20th percentile in the universe and the 14th percentile in the industrials sector.


Fundamentals as of 2 May 2024

The earnings per share for Tecnicas Reunidas is 0.88. The company earns a return on invested capital of 6.15%, falling at the 49th percentile in the industrials sector. The company did not report a dividend. We calculate the above figures over a trailing 12-month period.

Examining valuation further, we find Tecnicas Reunidas holds a price-to-earnings ratio of 10.58, a figure greater than 24% of its sector peers. The company's price-to-free cash flow ratio is 9.32, greater than 30% of its sector peers. These values are calculated using the stock's price at last market close.

Quantitative Equity Report Overview

The quantitative report on equities consists of data, statistics and quantitative equity ratings on equity securities. Morningstar, Inc.'s quantitative equity ratings are forward looking and are generated by a statistical model that is based on Morningstar Inc.'s analyst-driven equity ratings and quantitative statistics. Given the nature of the quantitative report and the quantitative ratings, there is no one analyst in which a given report is attributed to; however, Mr. Lee Davidson, Head of Quantitative Research for Morningstar, Inc., is responsible for overseeing the methodology that supports the quantitative equity ratings used in this report. As an employee of Morningstar, Inc., Mr. Davidson is guided by Morningstar, Inc.'s Code of Ethics and Personal Securities Trading Policy in carrying out his responsibilities.

Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings).

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analystdriven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. Please go to http://global.morningstar.com/ equitydisclosures for information about Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies.

ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10% Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

 $Very\ High\ -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

 $\ensuremath{\textit{Extreme}}\xspace -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Strong - assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. Last Close – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation**– Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk Categories (negligible, low, medium, high, severe). These risk categories are absolute, meaning that a 'high risk' assessment reflects a comparable degree



of unmanaged ESG risk across all subindustries covered.

The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale.
